

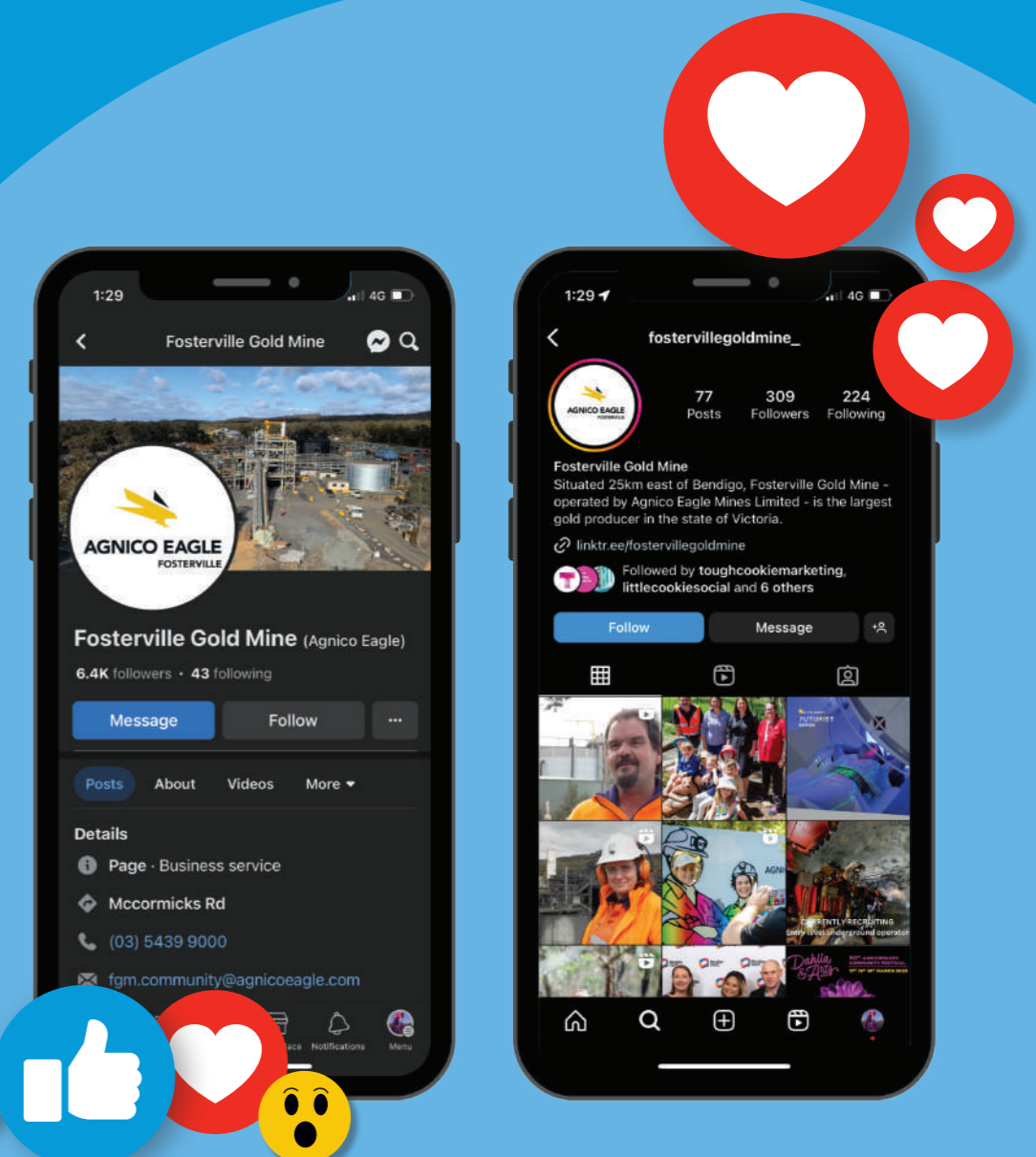
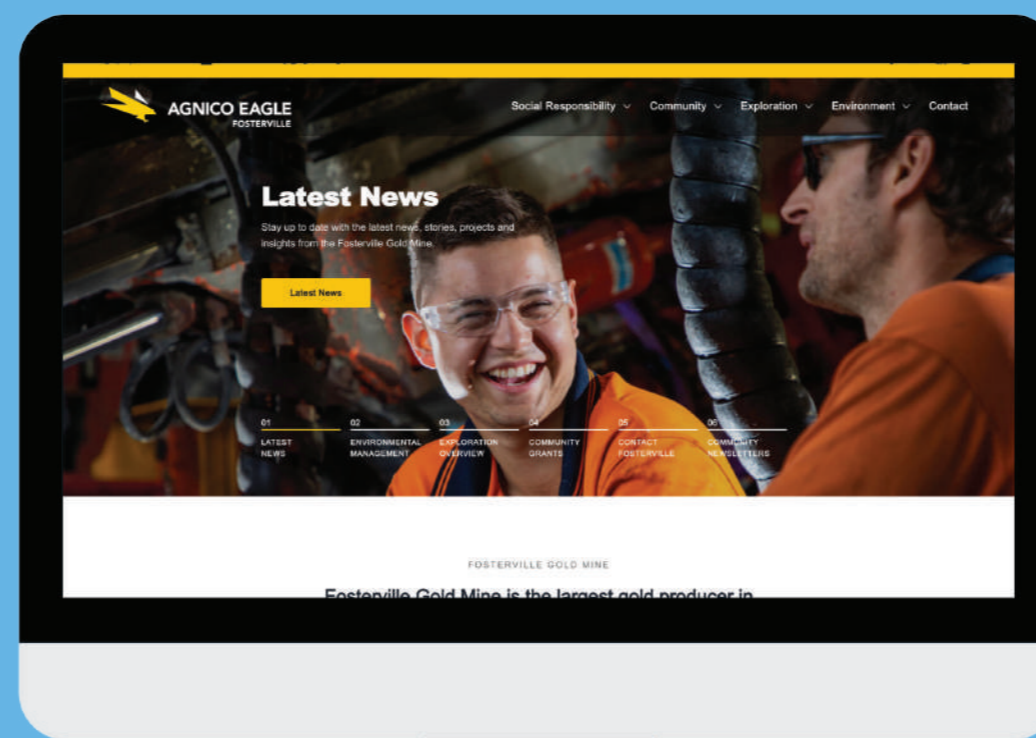
Community Engagement
